**Miss Arkansas Scholarship Pageant, Inc.
Contract-Free Agreement**

Your State Representative Must Be Contract Free

As a State Executive Director, it is very important that any contract you enter into with a commercial concern must be non-competitive with the Miss America Organization’s (MAO) National Sponsors. It must carry a clause to the effect that they cannot use the name, photograph or title of your State Representative in any advertising before, and including the night of the National Finals.

Furthermore, this clause must also stipulate that should your State Representative become Miss America, they can no longer use her name, title or photograph in any advertising whatsoever. These stipulations must be included in any contract or agreement between a business and your State Representative, as it is consistent with your State Titleholder’s Contestant Contract, declaring that she is contract-free.

Additionally, MAO Policy prohibits a finalist in the Miss America Pageant from receiving national publicity prior to the National Pageant unless approved by MAO in writing.
