Jean Bartel Quality of Life Scholarship Award

The Quality of Life Award honors the memory of Miss America 1943 Jean Bartel and is available to the 52 national contestants competing for the title of Miss America who exhibit exemplary community spirit!

Initiated in 1988, the Quality of Life Scholarship was the first community service related award presented to Miss America Contestants. All 52 national contestants competing for the title of Miss America are eligible for this award. Applicants must excel in their commitment to enhancing the quality of life for others through volunteerism and community service. The applicants must demonstrate that they have fulfilled a legitimate need in their community through the creation, development and/or participation in a community service project.

A separate Quality of Life panel of judges consisting of community leaders and former Miss Americas will review the applications and determine the top three (3) Quality of Life scholarship recipients. More information is provided in the on-line submission form below.
