How does the Miss America Organization serve Children's Miracle Network Hospitals?

Children's Miracle Network Hospitals is the official national platform of the Miss America Organization. Our partnership gives contestants competing at all levels of the Miss America system the added opportunity to serve their communities by raising funds for Children's Miracle Network Hospitals® and the Miss America Scholarship Fund.

What does this mean for contestants?

Contestants competing in Miss America-sponsored competitions raise a minimum of \$100 in donations for Children's Miracle Network Hospitals and the Miss America Scholarship Fund. Miss America is the national goodwill ambassador for Children's Miracle Network Hospitals, speaking on behalf of kids treated at children's hospitals and raising awareness around the country.
